The funds raised over the years have enabled the Lions to champion a wide range of local causes. Just in 2024 alone, they have already raised €25,630, adding to annual totals that exemplify the community's ongoing generosity. Here's how these donations are making a tangible difference:

Recent Impactful Contributions

. Supporting Teulada Alzheimer Foundation: In 2023, the Lions made their largest single donation to date, gifting €25,000 to the Teulada Alzheimer Foundation to purchase a new minibus. This vehicle helps transport individuals to essential care, while an additional €999 donation went toward a body hoist, improving safety and comfort for both patients and staff.

. Life-Saving Equipment for Emergency Services:

Recognizing the importance of rapid response in emergencies, the Lions have provided portable defibrillators to various local services. The Balcon al Mar Fire Service received a new defibrillator in 2023, and over the years, similar devices have been supplied to the Moraira paddle club, Civil Protection in Benitachell, the local swimming pool, and the Benitachell Police Station.

- Early Education Support: The Lions also recognize the importance of early childhood education, having donated €5,899 over nine years to the preschool in Benitachell, ensuring that young children have access to enriching learning environments.
- Festive Support for Children of Emaus: The Teulada Moraira Lions have been committed to brightening the lives of children at Emaus in El Vergel. Over the past decade, the Lions have provided over €18,000 to fund holiday gifts and Easter treats, bringing smiles to children who face challenging circumstances.
- Aiding the Homeless with Project For All: In 2023, the Lions supported Project For All, a non-profit helping homeless individuals in the Costa Blanca North region, with a donation of €10,000 toward a delivery minivan and emergency supplies. This initiative strengthens the community's support system for those in crisis, reaffirming the Lions' commitment to inclusivity and care.
- Special Education Resources for Raquel Payá School: The Lions have a long-standing relationship with Raquel Payá School in Denia, a special needs school serving children with diverse learning requirements. Over the years, they have provided essential resources, including a dishwasher, a washing machine, specialized educational equipment, and even an outdoor play area and sensory room.

Additional Causes and Ongoing Support

Beyond these core projects, the Teulada Moraira Lions also support a broad network of causes, including Caritas Food Bank, autism support programs, day care centers, Civil Protection, Gandia's Franciscan Hospice, women's shelters, and the Help of Denia organization. 7/ over 9 years we have donated 5899€ to the pre school in Benitachell

8/ to the Children of Emaus in El Vergel, another favourite support organisation the lions over many years have helped the children at Christmas and Easter with vouchers to help put a smile back on the faces of the Children of Emaus with over €18000.00 provided over 10 years.

9/ Project For All - a non profit organisation that helps and supports the homeless and those in need in Costa Blanca North. Their aim is to help build a community who look after each other in times of need. In 2023 €10,000.00were given towards a delivery/minivan together with emergency and food donations.

10/ another favourite and long term project we support is with Raquel Paya school in Denia. In 1986 this special school opened to provide educational and rehabilitation response to children with very specific educational needs. Again over many years the Teulada-Moraira Lions have developed a very strong and ongoing relationship with this innovative and worthy programme, supplying dishwasher, washing machine, an outside play area, sensory room as well as very specialised educational equipment.
